### Document Description:

To remove all user save files from the system easily and efficiently, the Work with Files command (WRKF) can be used. On any command line, type the following and then press the Enter key.

```
WRKF FILE(*ALLUSR./ *ALL) FILEATR(SAVF)
```

When the Work with Files detail screen is displayed, you will see a list of all user save files on your system. Place a “4” next to each save file that you wish to remove and press the Enter key. Press Enter again to confirm the deletion of the save files.
